NEW YORK CITY SIPS

Spanish winemaker **Judit Llop** arrived in New York with wines from the **Viticultors del Priorat** estate, owned by the Freixenet group. Part of the company's Heredad Collection, the premium portfolio features wines from six top appellations, including Ribera del Duero, Priorat and Montsant. Two red blends—2009 Mas de Subirà (SRP \$30), and the unusual 2007 Morlanda (SRP \$48)—showcased the intense, wild and brambly nature of the indigenous varieties, Garnacha Tinta and Cariñena. A third, the gateway 2011 Garbó (SRP \$19), proved to be its own animal—an easy blend of Syrah, Tempranillo and softened with 20% Merlot.



Morlanda, Mas de Subirà and Garbó are part of the Heredad Collection of ultra-premium wines selected to showcase the finest vineyards and leading DOs (Denominaciones de Origen) of Spain. Presented by the Ferrer family, these highly acclaimed wines reflect superior winemaking and focus on quality.
